Chef Fritz Sonnenschmidt

The GST BOCES Culinary Arts program, Chef Sonnenschmidt, the Culinary Institute of America, the GST BOCES Distance Learning Service and the NYSDistance Learning Consortium are collaborating to bring you this special event.



Chef Fritz Sonnenschmidt is one of 66 Certified Master Chefs in America, the highest certification bestowed by the American Culinary Federation (ACF). In 2002, Chef Sonnenschmidt retired as Culinary Dean of the Culinary Institute of America after 34 years at the prestigious college and is one of the longest-serving members of the CIA faculty. As a member of the U.S. Culinary Olympic Team, he won gold medals at the International Culinary Competition in Frankfurt, Germany in 1976, 1984, and 1988. He was named the American Culinary Federation’s 1994 National Chef of the Year and is a member of the Hall of Fame of the American Academy of Chefs. Chef Sonnenschmidt has also co-authored several culinary books including “Tastes and Tales of a Chef”, “The Professional Chefs Art of Garde Manger” and “Dining with Sherlock Holmes.”
